## *A Brief History of Göhren and the Mönchgut Peninsula*

The earliest evidence of human settlement on the Mönchgut Peninsula dates back to the Middle Stone Age, around 8,000 BC.

One of the most remarkable remains from this early period is the Neolithic “Herzogsgrab” burial site (Duke’s Tomb) in the Baaber Heide. The burial mounds, including the Speckbusch near the church in Göhren, date back to the Bronze Age.

Mönchgut owes its name to the monks of Eldena Abbey near Greifswald. They acquired the area, known as “Mönke Gut”, in 1252 and remained its owners until the Reformation in 1535. After the Reformation, Mönchgut became part of the Pomeranian ducal house. Following the end of the Thirty Years’ War in 1648, the island of Rügen came under Swedish rule. Swedish rule lasted until 1815, when Rügen was assigned to Prussia at the Congress of Vienna. The village of Göhren has a history spanning more than 850 years. In 2015, the Baltic Sea resort officially celebrated its 850th anniversary.

Göhren was granted the title of “Baltic Sea resort” as early as 1878. Since then, tourism has played an important role in shaping the village and its economy. Many of Göhren’s most recognisable landmarks date from this period, including the beach promenade, the pier and the historic bandstand, all of which continue to characterise the resort today.

**Visitor's tax: Main Season (01/05-31/10 and 20/12-06/01)  
Off Season (07/01-30/04 and 01/11-19/12)**

The visitor's tax is charged per day. Both the arrival and departure days are counted as full days (last updated: April 2026).

**You are a day visitor in Göhren?**

If you are a day visitor in the Baltic Sea resort of Göhren and already have a valid guest card for the Baltic Sea resorts of Mönchgut, Baabe or Sellin, your card is also valid in Göhren.

Otherwise, the following applies: day visitors staying in the Baltic Sea resort of Göhren without spending the night here are also required to pay the visitor's tax. Day guest cards are available from guest card and parking ticket machines, as well as from the Tourist Information Office and the Information point at the pier. The location of the machines can be found on the local map of Göhren on pages 24/25 of this booklet.

The local bus “BUSkam” in Göhren offers many benefits:

- Free with a guest card
- Takes you and everything you need to the beach
- The bus is available all year round. From May to October, it also runs in the evenings. From November to April, the bus is available from Friday to Sunday and on public holidays.
- The bus is wheelchair accessible. Wheelchair users and passengers with strollers can travel easily and comfortably.
- Dogs and luggage are also allowed on the bus

Additional charges may apply for dogs, bicycles and other items. Current timetables are available at the Tourist Information Office, from many accommodation providers and other locations, as well as on the bus and at all bus stops.

**Tip:** Leave your car behind. With your Göhren Guest Card, you can use the VVR bus routes between Klein Zicker, Zirkow and Dalkvitz, as well as the boats of the “Weiße Flotte” in Baabe and Sellin, free of charge.

# *The inclined lift in the Baltic Sea resort of Göhren*

For many years, Göhren looked for a solution to overcome the large height difference between the town centre and the North Beach area. Today, a modern and fully glazed lift connects the town centre with the North Beach, including the pier, beach promenade, spa gardens, railway station and campsite.

Visitors with strollers, wheelchairs or beach equipment can use the lift instead of the stairs or the steep footpath.

## **Price Per Ride**

All passengers, including wheelchair users and passengers with strollers (if they can access the cabin) pay 1.00 € per ride.

Bicycles are not allowed on the inclined lift. Wheelchair users can request a refund at the Tourist Information Office. Tickets can be purchased from the machines at the upper and lower lift stations.

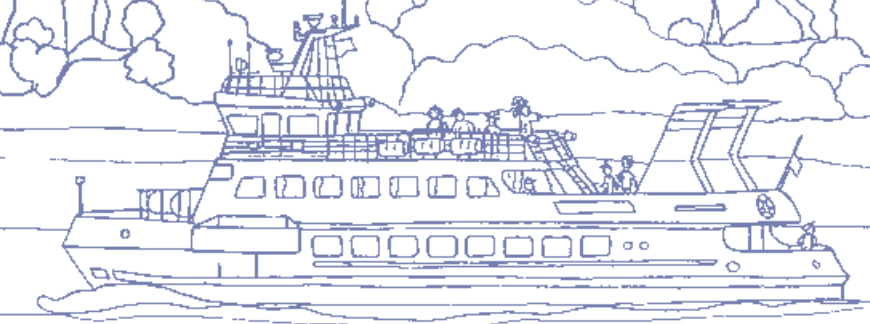

Discover the Mönchgut region from Göhren and experience its traditions, nature and culture – on foot, by bike, with the buses of the Verkehrsgesellschaft Vorpommern-Rügen Transport company (VVR) or with the boats of the “Weiße Flotte” shipping company.





With a guest card from the Baltic Sea resorts of Baabe, Göhren, Mönchgut or Sellin, you can use public transport within the network free of charge. Only passengers changing to the “Rasender Roland” steam railway need to buy a ticket.

## Your guest card = your free ticket

### **Mönchgut-Granitz public bus service**

The VVR bus routes 20, 21 and 29 connect the whole holiday region from Dalkvitz via Zirkow, Sellin, Baabe and Göhren to the Mönchgut peninsula. From May to October, the “RADzfatz” buses also run and can transport up to 12 bicycles in their trailer (extra charges apply).

### **Local bus routes and tourist road trains**

During the summer months, these services connect all main destinations in the Baltic Sea resorts of Sellin, Baabe and Göhren.

### **Line traffic of the “Weiße Flotte” shipping company**

From March to October, two boats and a solar-powered ferry operated by the “Weiße Flotte” shipping company travel between Sellin, Baabe, Gager, Thiessow and Lauterbach. The routes cross Lake Sellin and the Baaber Bek and pass the beautiful island of Vilm. Passengers can enjoy wonderful views of the Bodden landscape during the journey. Travel between our Baltic Sea resorts is free of charge. Only trips to Lauterbach require a ticket with a reduced price.

## *Göhren Museum of Local History*

Experience tradition and history in a modern way



The Göhren Museum of Local History, originally a traditional farmhouse, opened in the heart of Göhren on 1 May 1963. Following extensive renovation work, the permanent exhibition now presents not only the traditional costumes of the Mönchgut region, but also the historical development of the area, with a special focus on local habits and traditions. Modern and multimedia presentation methods bring the exhibition to life.

One of the museum's highlights are the original artefacts from the legendary Duke's Tomb in the Mönchgut Forest. These 5,000-year-old grave goods were discovered more than 100 years ago by researchers from the University of Greifswald and have been on permanent loan to the museum since 2023.

# Rookhus Göhren Museum

The architecturally unique historic smoke house ("Rookhus" in Low German) offers fascinating insights into the traditional way of life of the fishermen of the Mönchgut region. Built around 1700, the house is known as "Sugar Loaf" because of its distinctive roof shape and is one of the oldest buildings on the island of Rügen.

## Göhren Museum Farm

The Göhren Museum Farm is the oldest and largest open-air museum on the island of Rügen and offers fascinating insights into the region's agricultural history. Visitors can experience the everyday life and work of the former fishermen, farmers and rural craftsmen of the Mönchgut region.

The museum complex in the Baltic Sea resort of Göhren includes a farmhouse from the mid-19th century, a barn dating back to the 17th century, a pigsty from the 19th century, a cart and tool shed, as well as a herb and flower garden.

Unfortunately, the museum farm is currently closed except during special events. We hope to welcome you again soon.

# Explore Göhren!



The Baltic Sea resort of Göhren is located on the Mönchgut peninsula, in the heart of the UNESCO Southeast Rügen Biosphere Reserve.



# Highlights of Göhren

- 1 Bernsteinpromenade beach promenade with spa gardens and pier**  
Cozy cafés, stylish restaurants, many benches and a large playground create a relaxed holiday atmosphere by the beach and the sea. The approximately 3-kilometre-long beach promenade connects Göhren with the neighbouring Baltic Sea resorts of Baabe and Sellin. One of the highlights are the spa gardens with their historic bandstand and the Kneipp Garden at the end of the promenade. To the left of the promenade square is the 280-metres-long pier, built in 1993, from where boat trips to the famous chalk cliffs depart.
- 2 The Buskam boulder**  
The Buskam is the largest boulder on the German Baltic coast. It is located around 350 metres off the North Beach and weighs approximately 550 tonnes. At its widest point, the boulder has a circumference of 24 metres. The name “Buskam” comes from the Old Slavic term “bogis kamien”, which means “God’s stone”.
- 3 The Nordperd headland**  
The Nordperd is a wooded headland rising up to 60 metres above sea level and marks the easternmost point of the island of Rügen. A beautiful clifftop path leads through the forest and the core zone of the UNESCO Southeast Rügen Biosphere Reserve, offering spectacular coastal views along the way.
- 4 The Storm Signal**  
In the past, this was an important landmark for sailors. Today, it still reflects the area’s long tradition.
- 5 Salzsteg-Soltwech Gorge**  
A gorge known as the “Salz-Schlucht” leads down to the South Beach. Its name comes from a herring salting facility, built there by the Prussian government in 1816. Salt was transported through the “Salz-Schlucht” to preserve the large herring catches.

## 6 The Swedish Pier

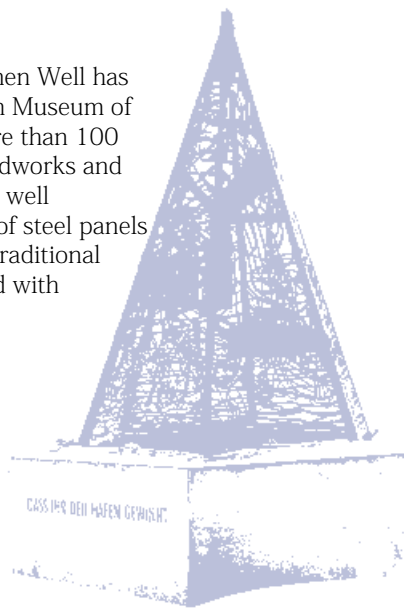
The Swedish Pier was built in 1813 by the Swedish government to provide an easier landing place for soldiers involved in the war against Napoleon. However, the pier lost its military importance in 1815. Until 1859, it continued to be used as a landing place by pilots. The pier originally consisted of 12 stone chests and was about 280 metres long and 6 metres wide. When the water level is low, parts of the original wooden framing can still be seen today.

## 7 The church with the viewpoint Speckbusch

The Göhren church is the newest church on the Mönchgut peninsula and was sanctified in May 1930. Particularly striking are the four stained-glass windows with maritime motifs and the altar figures created by the Tyrolean woodcarver Ferdinand Stuessler. They depict Mary and John as a fishing couple wearing traditional Mönchgut costumes. Behind the church lies the Speckbusch burial mound, which is believed to date back to the Bronze Age. Today, it is popular because of its peaceful atmosphere and the beautiful views across the Mönchgut peninsula.

## 8 The Sagenbrunnen Well

Since summer 2007, the Sagenbrunnen Well has stood directly opposite of the Göhren Museum of Local History. The well, which is more than 100 years old, was discovered during roadworks and later extensively restored. Today, the well features a hexagonal pyramid made of steel panels mounted on its original base with a traditional inscription. The pyramid is decorated with motifs inspired by local legends.



# Time for the beach!



Stretching for 1.5 kilometres and featuring 24 beach accesses, Göhren's North Beach offers plenty of space to relax on the fine Baltic Sea sand. Visitors can also enjoy a wide range of activities for a perfect holiday by the sea.

- Non-nudist beach areas, nudist beach areas, non-smoking beach areas and dog-friendly beach areas, each with and without beach chairs
- A total of more than 400 beach chairs
- Tiki Beach sports beach with beach volleyball and beach soccer courts, stand-up paddleboard and skim board hire, and weekly beach parties from June to September
- Mobile beach snack service with a wide selection of ice cream
- The Baltic Sea resort of Göhren has been awarded the "Lifeguarded Beach" certification

Relax, enjoy a long walk along the beach and leave everyday life behind. Watch children playing in the fine sand, listen to the sound of the waves or take a refreshing swim in the sea yourself. To ensure safety and enjoyment for all visitors, DLRG lifeguards are on duty at the North Beach from May to September. We are especially proud that, in 2026, Göhren received the "Blaue Flagge" award for excellent water quality for the 25th time.

# *Tips for excursions and ticket service at the Tourist Information Office*

The Baltic Sea resort of Göhren is an ideal base for exploring the island of Rügen and the surrounding area. Whether you prefer to travel by bus, train, bike or on foot, the Tourist Information Office can help you plan your trip and offers a wide range of excursions that can be booked directly on site.

## **Guided Coach Tours**

### **■ North Rügen**

Discover some of Rügen's most famous attractions on this guided coach tour. The journey takes you through the town of Bergen and on to Ralswiek, home to Europe's largest natural amphitheatre. Along the way to Cape Arkona, you will learn fascinating facts about the island and its history. Enjoy two hours to explore Cape Arkona before continuing to Jasmund National Park and the famous chalk cliffs, where there will be around one hour to take in the stunning scenery. The tour then continues through the town of Sassnitz, the ferry port of Mukran, Prora and Binz before returning to the Baltic Sea resorts.

### **■ Stralsund**

Enjoy a scenic drive along the famous tree-lined Avenue to the Hanseatic city of Stralsund. After a guided tour of around two hours, you will have free time to explore the city and its attractions on your own.



## ■ Hiddensee Island

Enjoy a trip to the Island of Hiddensee, including a ferry ride from Schaprode to Kloster. The excursion features a guided tour of the island, a walk to the lighthouse and some free time to explore the island's unique charm on your own.

Please note: Additional dates (also for other destinations) may be available at short notice.

All excursions require a minimum number of participants.

Tickets for bus and boat trips can be purchased from the Tourist Information Office (Poststraße 9) and from the Information point at the pier. Please note that boat schedules may change due to bad weather.

## Boat Trips

### ■ Chalk Cliffs or „Wasser & Dampf“ (Water & Steam) Combined Ticket

Enjoy spectacular panoramic views of Rügen's famous chalk cliffs from the sea aboard an "Adler Schiffe" passenger ship. Departures are available from Göhren, Sellin, Binz and Sassnitz. As part of the "Wasser & Dampf" tour, you leave the boat in Binz on the return journey and continue to Göhren aboard the historic steam railway "Rasender Roland".

### ■ Trips departing from Sellin, Baabe, Gager, Thiessow and Lauterbach

Enjoy a boat trip aboard the passenger ships "MS Kleine Freiheit" and "MS Sellin" across the Rügen Bodden. Departing from Lauterbach, Baabe, Gager and Thiessow, the route takes you past the island of Vilm. In addition, the solar-powered ferry "MS Sünje" provides a convenient shuttle service between the harbours of Sellin and Baabe.

### ■ "Wasser & Dampf" (Water & Steam) Mönchgut Combined Ticket

Discover the Mönchgut region by "Wasser & Dampf". Leave your car behind and enjoy a combination of a relaxing boat trip between Lauterbach, Baabe and Sellin with a journey on the historic steam railway "Rasender Roland". Whether you choose to begin your excursion by boat or by train is entirely up to you. Boats depart from the harbours of Lauterbach, Baabe (Bollwerk) and Sellin. From Sellin, Baabe or Lauterbach, you can travel on the "Rasender Roland" and return to your original starting point.

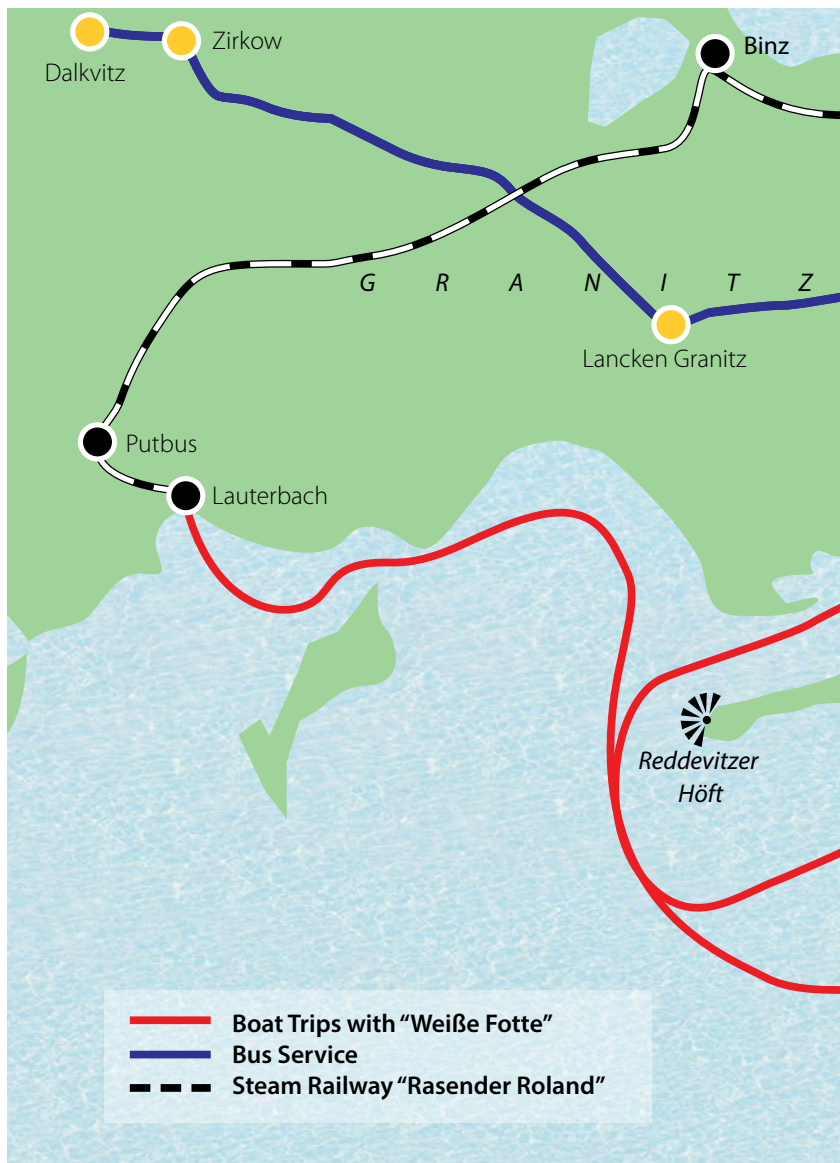

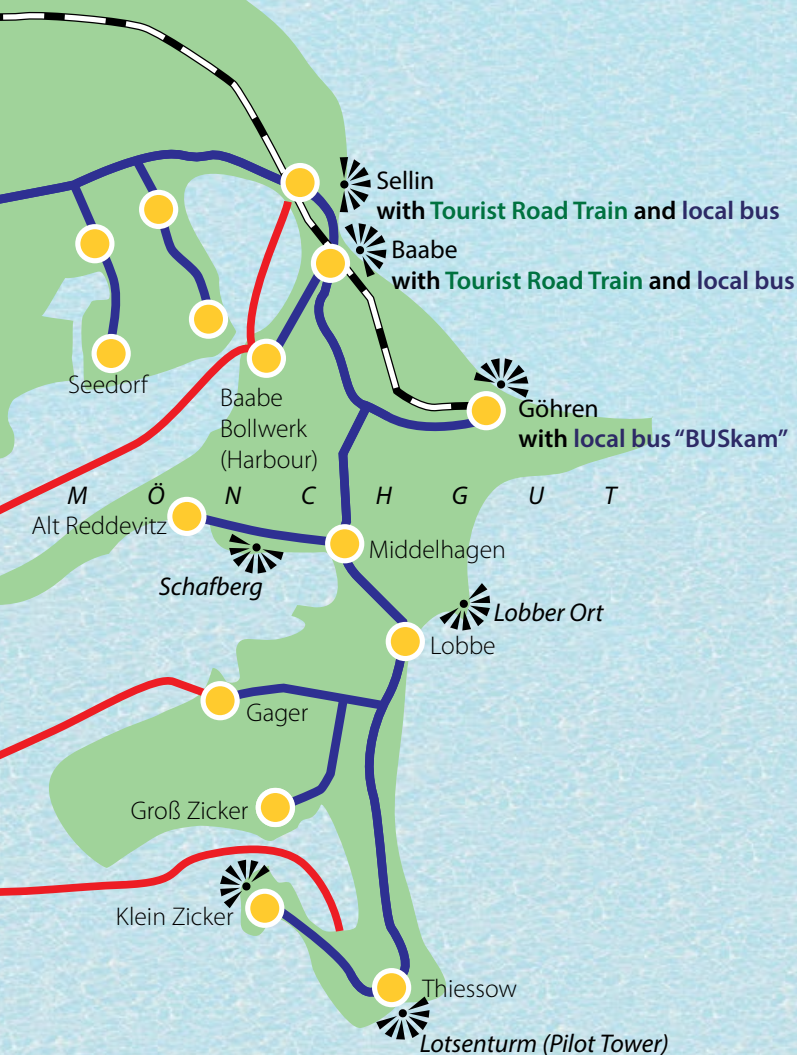

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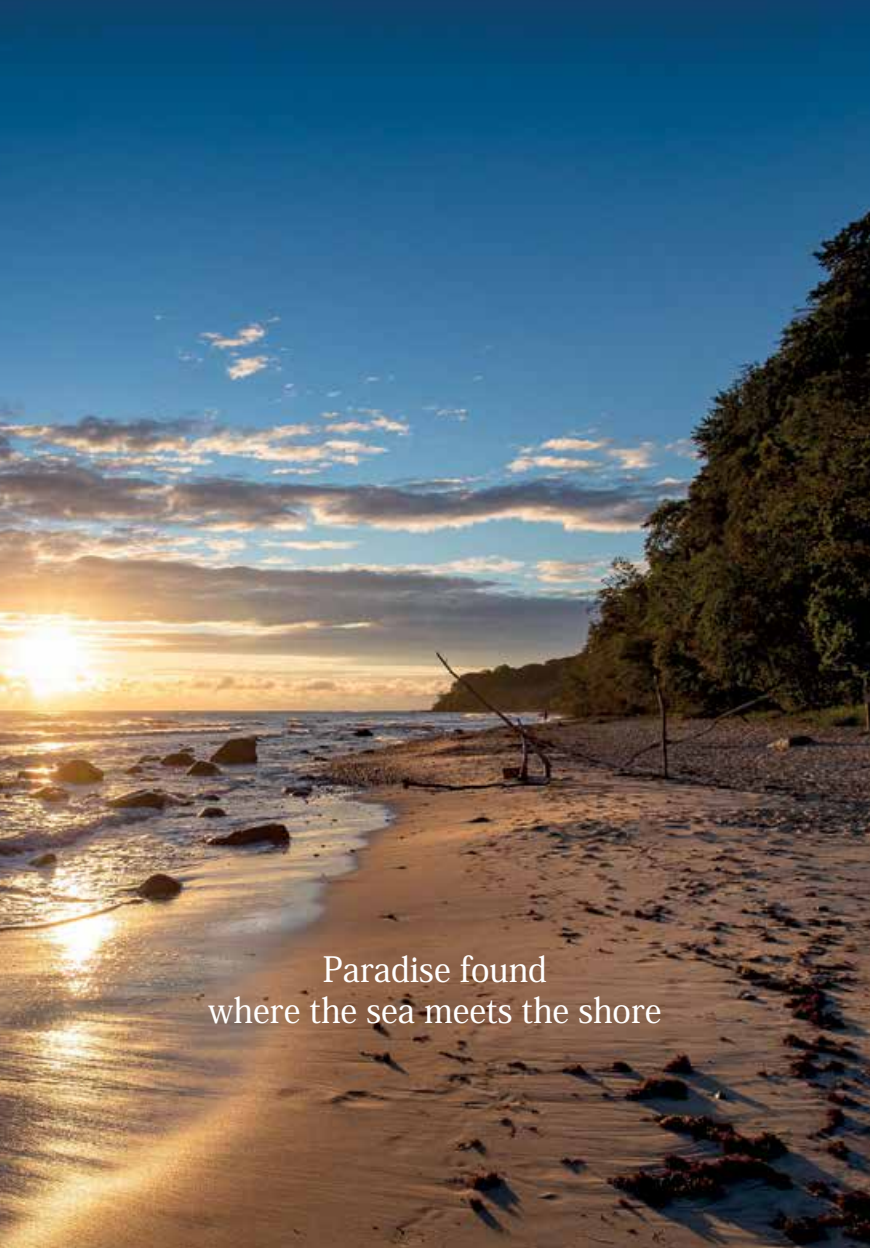
